


Howie Kenty is a Brooklyn-based composer and performer, occasionally known by his musical alter-ego, Hwarg. His music, called "remarkable" with "astonishing poetic power" by the International Compendium Prix Ars Electronica, is stylistically diverse, encompassing ideas from contemporary classical, electronic, rock, sound art, theatre, and everything in between, occasionally with visual and theatrical elements. Howie plays guitar in the progressive rock band The Benzene Ring, and is currently a Graduate Council Fellow ABD PhD candidate at Stony Brook University. Recent recognition includes residencies at the Copland House (2017), the Virginia Center for the Creative Arts (2018), and the Oberpfälzer Künstlerhaus (2019), as well as first prize commission in the 2017 Null-state Chaosflöte competition and competition winner in both the 2018 Open Space Festival of New Music and the 2018 RED NOTE New Music Festival Composition Workshop.

# Anne Krinsky



Anne Krinsky works across analogue and digital media – painting, printmaking, photography and video. Historical, geographical and visual research underpins her practice. She has made installations in response to archived materials in the US, UK and India. She is fascinated by the ways in which built and natural structures change over time. Her "Tide Line Thames" project explored the river and its architecture between high and low tide lines. Her video installation in the Brunel Museum's Thames Tunnel Shaft and a digital print commission for Canary Wharf's Crossrail Place Roof Garden were part of London's "Totally Thames" in 2017. Krinsky has been awarded an Artists International Development Fund Grant and two Arts Council England Grants for the Arts. She is working on a new project about wetlands and climate change. Her initial research focused on the Thames Estuary, during a 2018 Residency with METAL, in Southend-on-Sea, UK. Previous residencies include Sanskriti Foundation (Delhi), Fundacion Valparaiso (Spain), Millay Colony for the Arts (New York), Rocky Neck Art Colony (Massachusetts) and Virginia Center for the Arts.

# Lisa Young

Lisa Young acts as a visual interpreter, sifting through the image sediment. Her hybrid practice includes photo installations, video, and artist books. Through collecting, analyzing, and repositioning everyday images (snapshots of the sky, sports from broadcast TV), she explores ways in which the repetitive action of accumulating and organizing can create its own poetics and act as a cultural mirror. Young's exhibition venues include the Cue Art Foundation, The Getty Research Institute, White Columns, Bard College, and Spektrum Berlin. Her commissioned projects include a billboard at 6150 Wilshire Boulevard, LA (Clockshop), an artist book with Cabinet Magazine, and a web archive with the STG at Brown University. Her work is in collections at MoMA, NY, RISD, the Harvard Art Museums, the Archive for New Media Art, Cornell University, and the Neues Museum Weserberg in Bremen. Young was a Fellow in the Whitney ISP, a recipient of a NEA/NEFA Fellowship (works on paper) and a two-time recipient of Rhode Island State Council for the Arts Fellowships (photography, film/video). She has held two residencies at the Virginia Center for the Creative Arts. Young received her MFA from the SMFA Boston/Tufts University.
